Focus: Service Integration and Outreach

- Addressing groups of particular vulnerability in the labour market
- Integrate services by redesign of services and/or cooperation among different service providers and professions
- Apply a holistic view on clients
- Empower families
- Include Reach-Out-Practices into the portfolio of services



Target Groups

- **Offenbach** (Germany): **Immigrants** from Romania and Bulgaria (of which some ^{PS1} belong to the Roma-community)
- **Budapest** (Hungary): **Households at risk of poverty** (recipients of housing assistance, inactive and longterm unemployed persons)
- **Lučenec and Spišské Podhradie** (Slovakia): **Marginalised groups and ethnic minorities** with a distance to the labour market and multiple deprivations

Ressources

- **Offenbach** (Germany): The German model of municipal jobcenter as an agency for integrated service delivery (benefits, employment services, social work)
- **Budapest** (Hungary): Neighborhood development and housing; social space as a resource for empowerment
- **Lučenec and Spišské Podhradie** (Slovakia): Well developed competencies in the work with ethnic minorities, e. g. Roma; localized approach



Objectives

- **Offenbach** (Germany): Implement **systemic** counselling as a tool for employment services for groups at risk of exclusion; put families in focus
- **Budapest** (Hungary): Relate social work for the most disadvantaged with employment; implement a systemic approach to client families
- **Lučenec and Spišské Podhradie** (Slovakia): Overcome fragmentation of service delivery by contracting out employment services to a private non-for-profit provider

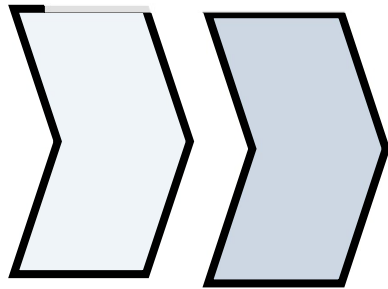


Elements of a Systemic / Holistic Approach

Culture-Sensitive Counselling



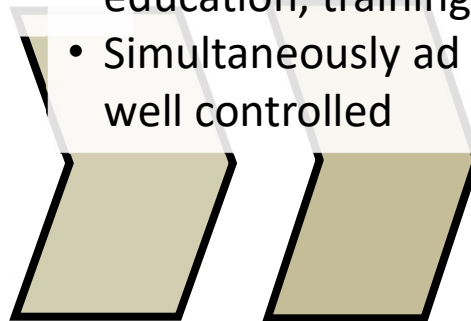
- Get access

Case Management with Focus on Employment



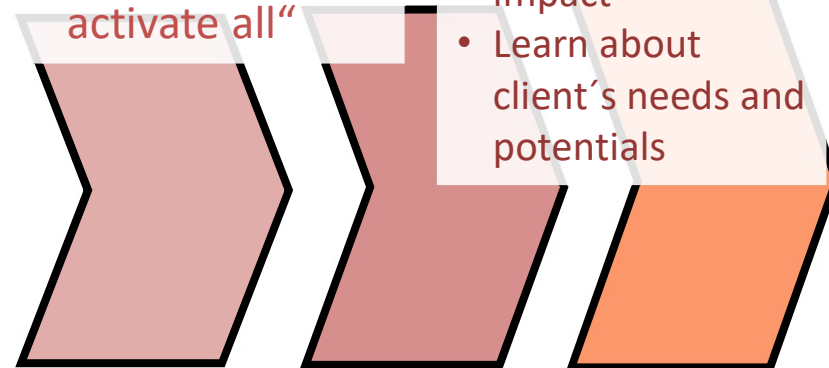
- Tackle a variety of problems (e. g. job-search, housing, education, training)
